Grades are FINAL after each 9 weeks. Students are forbidden to revisit any assignments after each 9 week period has closed. It is important for students to complete make-ups within this time window. Students are held responsible for addressing any missed assignments.

All missing assignments will reflect a zero in the Gradebook until the assignment is submitted and graded. DO NOT BE ALARMED if you see a zero for an assignment in which you were absent. You will be given the opportunity to make up the assignment. My job is to encourage. This tactic usually does the trick!

If a student misses a Quiz/Test, I will expect he or she to be prepared to take the exam upon return to school. This only applies if the student was present for a reasonable amount of days leading up to the exam including the review. This will also be determined at the Teacher's Discretion.
